CONSENT ORDER

Respondent.

The Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions (“Department”) has received evidence that Danielle Thornton (“Thornton” or “Respondent”) violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes (“A.R.S.”). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of Fact are true, and consent to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On November 24, 2020, the Department issued to Thornton an Arizona resident insurance producer license with lines of authority in life insurance, and accident and health or sickness insurance, National Producer Number 19716484. Thornton’s license is scheduled to expire on September 30, 2024.

2. Thornton’s address of record with the Department is 12210 W. Locust Lane, Avondale, AZ 85323-7683 (business and mailing). Her business e-mail address is dontworryaboutme21@yahoo.com.

3. On November 19, 2020, Thornton submitted an application to the Department for an Arizona insurance producer license through the National Insurance Producer Registry (“Application”).

1 **ORDER**

2 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

3 1. **Danielle Thornton's** insurance producer license, number 19716484, is
4 immediately surrendered.

5 2. **Danielle Thornton** agrees that she will not apply for any license subject to
6 regulation by the Department for a period of at least one (1) year from the issuance of this
7 Order.

13 **CONSENT TO ORDER**

14 1. Respondent has reviewed the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and
15 Order.

16 2. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Director of the Arizona Department of
17 Insurance and Financial Institutions and admits the foregoing Findings of Fact and consents to
18 the entry of the foregoing Conclusions of Law and Order.

21 4. Respondent irrevocably waives her right to such notice and hearing and to any
22 court appeals relating to this Consent Order.

1 5. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
2 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to induce her to enter into this Consent
3 Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

4 6. Respondent acknowledges and agrees that the acceptance of this Consent Order by
5 the Director is solely to settle this matter and does not preclude the Department from instituting
6 other proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future. Furthermore, and notwithstanding
7 any language in this Consent Order, this Consent Order does not preclude in any way any other
8 state agency or officer or political subdivision of this state from instituting proceedings,
9 investigating claims, or taking legal action as may be appropriate now or in the future relating to
10 this matter or other matters concerning Respondent, including but not limited to violations of
11 Arizona's Consumer Fraud Act. Respondent acknowledges that, other than with respect to the
12 Department, this Consent Order makes no representations, implied or otherwise, about the views
13 or intended actions of any other state agency or officer or political subdivision of the state
14 relating to this matter or other matters concerning Respondent.

15 7. Respondent acknowledges that his Consent Order is an administrative action that
16 the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC).
17 Respondent further acknowledges that she must report this administrative action to any and all
18 states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative action on
19 any license application.


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1 8. Respondent waives all rights to seek an administrative or judicial review or
