Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance and Financial Institutions by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions ("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Harleysville Life Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is an Ohio domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact life and disability insurance in Arizona effective September 6, 1963.
2. Effective January 1, 2022, Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Nationwide Life and Annuity Insurance Company (NLAIC), NAIC No. 92657, an Ohio domiciled insurer and the surviving entity. NLAIC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
3. The Insurance Commissioner of Ohio approved the merger of Petitioner into NLAIC on October 18, 2021.

1 4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether
2 written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are
3 residents of this State.

4 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct
5 examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

6 6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund
7 ("IERF").

8 7. Petitioner's 2021 Annual Statement and Annual Tax and Fees Report together
9 with payment of all applicable fees are due to this Department March 1, 2022.

10 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

11 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-
12 303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.

13 **ORDER**

14 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

15 2. Petitioner shall file its 2021 Annual Statement and Annual Tax and Fees Report
16 together with payment of all applicable fees.

17 3. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the sum of \$100.00 that was
18 previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
