On August 23, 2023, the Arizona Department of Insurance and Financial Institutions (the "Department") issued a Notice of Hearing ("Notice") in the above-captioned matter, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit A** and incorporated by this reference. The Notice required Melissa Jean Madrigal ("Respondent") to provide a written answer to the allegations set forth in the Notice within twenty days of the issuance of the Notice. As of this date, Respondent has failed to file an answer. On September 20, 2023, counsel for the Department filed a Motion for Default, a copy of which is attached as **Exhibit B**. As of this date, Respondent has not responded to the Department's motion. Pursuant to A.A.C. R20-6-106(D), a party that fails to file an answer within the time provided shall be deemed to be in default and one or more of the allegations in the Notice of Hearing may be deemed to be admitted.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Notice was proper.
- 2. Respondent is in default.
- 3. The allegations in the Notice are deemed admitted.

The purpose of this Hearing is to determine whether grounds exist to revoke Respondent's insurance producer license. In support of its position that grounds exist, the Department alleges the following:

PARTIES & JURISDICTION

- 1. The Department was created and enabled to administer certain laws of the State of Arizona by protecting the public interest through licensure and regulation of the insurance producer profession in this state. A.R.S. § 20-142 and A.R.S. §§ 20-281 et seq.
- 2. Melissa Jean Madrigal ("Madrigal" or "Respondent") is licensed in Arizona as a non-resident insurance producer, National Producer Number 16452605.
- 3. The Office of Administrative Hearings has subject matter and personal jurisdiction over the named parties in this Notice of Hearing under A.R.S. § 20-161 and A.R.S. §§ 41-1092 et seq.

FACTS

4. Madrigal was at all material times licensed in Arizona as a non-resident insurance producer, National Producer Number 16452605, with a line of authority in accident and health

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or sickness insurance. The Department licensed Madrigal on August 15, 2022 and her license is scheduled to expire on March 31, 2026. Madrigal's home state is Florida.

- 5. Madrigal has the following addresses on record with the Department: 546 Ballough Road, Daytona Beach, FL 32114 (business and mailing) and contracting@medicareinsurance.com (e-mail).
- 6. On December 27, 2022, the Department received a referral from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services ("CMS") that included a copy of a "Notice of Termination of PY 2023 FFE Registration and Agreements Effective December 27, 2022" ("Notice") that CMS sent to Madrigal. In the Notice, CMS alleged that Madrigal assisted consumers and facilitated health plan enrollment during a period when she did not have a valid license in her home state of Florida.
- 7. The Department reviewed the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC) producer database report for Madrigal. The NAIC report showed Madrigal's resident producer license in Florida was issued by the Florida Department of Financial Services on August 12, 2022 and then "cancelled – surrendered" on November 2, 2022.
- 8. On March 3, 2023, the Department sent an email to Madrigal informing her that she was in violation of Arizona law due to her failure to be licensed as a resident in her home state and offering her the opportunity to voluntarily surrender her Arizona nonresident producer license on or before March 24, 2023. Madrigal did not respond to the email.
- 9. On March 27, 2023, the Department sent a second email to Madrigal, again offering her the opportunity to voluntarily surrender her Arizona nonresident producer license on or before March 31, 2023. Madrigal did not respond to the email.

- 10. On May 4, 2023, the Department called Madrigal at the phone number on file and left a voicemail requesting a call back or a response by email. The Department did not receive any calls or voicemails from Madrigal.
- 11. On May 22, 2023, the Department sent a third email to Madrigal informing her that the Department had been attempting to reach her and requesting a response by 2:00 p.m. on the following day. The Department further provided that it would start legal proceedings to revoke her license if the Department did not receive a response.
- 12. On the same day, Madrigal responded to the email and stated, "Surrender license."

 I am not a resident of Florida any longer."
- 13. The Department responded and instructed Madrigal to complete the form attached to the email and return it to the Department immediately. Madrigal did not fill out the attached form or respond to the email.
- 14. The Department has not received any correspondence from Madrigal since her one and only response email from May 22, 2023.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 15. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 16. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes failing to respond to a Department request in an investigative matter, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-157(A).
- 17. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes failing to maintain a license in good standing in the person's home state, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-287(A)(1).

- 18. Respondent's conduct, as described above, constitutes violating any provision of Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).
- 19. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew Respondent's insurance license, pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-157(A), 20-287(A)(1) and 20-295(A)(2).

THEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, the Department requests:

- 1. Respondent Melissa Jean Madrigal's Arizona non-resident insurance producer license, National Producer Number 16452605, be revoked under those statutes and rules cited, and any other applicable statutes or rules; and
 - 2. Any further relief that the tribunal deems appropriate.

On December 27, 2022, the Department received a referral from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services ("CMS") that included a copy of a "Notice of Termination of PY 2023 FFE Registration and Agreements Effective December 27, 2022" ("Notice") that CMS sent to Madrigal. In the Notice, CMS alleged that Madrigal assisted

 consumers and facilitated health plan enrollment during a period when she did not have a valid license in her home state of Florida.
