**CONSENT ORDER**

The Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Michael Joseph Palomino II ("Palomino") and Palomino Insurance Agency Inc. ("the Agency") (collectively "Respondents") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S"). Respondents wish to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Finding of Fact are true, and consent to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Palomino is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident insurance producer with four lines of authority: life, accident and health or sickness, casualty, and property. Palomino's license, number 135783, was last renewed on September 1, 2018 and it is scheduled to expire on August 31, 2022.

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- 2. Palomino's business and mailing address of record with the Department is: C/O Palomino Insurance Agency, 14555 N Scottsdale Road, Suite 320, Scottsdale, Arizona 85254-3487. Palomino's business e-mail address of record with the Department is michael@palominol.com.
- 3. The Agency is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona business entity insurance producer with four lines of authority: life, accident and health or sickness, casualty, and property. The Agency's license, number 10165149, was last renewed on February 1, 2020 and it is scheduled to expire on January 31, 2024.
- 4. Palomino is the President and Designated Responsible Licensed Producer of the Agency and as such is responsible for the business entity's compliance with the insurance laws of this state, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(C)(3).

## **Consumer Complaint**

- 6. On or about January 3, 2020, a consumer submitted a written complaint to the Department alleging the Respondents failed to forward his annual insurance premium to the insurer resulting in a lapse in his homeowner insurance policy.
- 7. The consumer advised the Respondents' actions caused him financial harm when his home was damaged on or about December 2019 and his discovery that his homeowner policy was not in force.
  - 8. The Department's investigation revealed the consumer's homeowner policy

was placed in force for the month of July 2018 and was subsequently canceled for nonpayment on the following month.

- The Department's investigation confirmed the consumer's annual premium of \$749.00 was received and deposited by the Respondents on July 6, 2018.
- 10. On February 27, 2020, the Department conducted an Examination Under Oath ("EUO") with Palomino. During the EUO, Palomino acknowledged that unintentional mistakes were made by one of his employees under his supervision in the handling of this consumer's policy and premium transaction.
- 11. Palomino stated that on or about January 2020, he issued the consumer a full refund of his premium. Palomino subsequently provided, to the consumer, his Errors and Omissions insurance policy information.
- 12. Palomino stated he has since made changes at his business practices in an effort to prevent the circumstances described herein from occurring again in the future.

## **Change of Address and Members**

- 13. During this EUO, the Department discovered Palomino neglected to update the business entity license in regards to the change in address and membership of The Agency.
- 14. Palomino stated he had moved The Agency to the new location on or about July 2019 and his attempts to update the address via the Department's website were unsuccessful. He further stated that he divorced his wife on or about February 2019 and neglected to remove her name from the membership of The Agency.
- Following this EUO, Palomino updated the membership, business and mailing addresses for The Agency.

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
- 2. Respondents' conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the Director, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).
- 3. Respondents' conduct, as described above, constitutes improperly withholding monies or properties received in the course of doing insurance business, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(4).
- 4. Respondents' conduct, as described above, constitutes failing to inform the director in writing within thirty days of any change in the licensee's residential, business or email address; members, directors, officers, or designated producer, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-286(C)(1) and (2).
- 5. Grounds exist, such that, the Director may impose a civil penalty of not more than two hundred fifty dollars for each unintentional failure or violation up to an aggregate civil penalty of two thousand five hundred dollars, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(F)(1).

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## **ORDER**

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Michael Joseph Palomino II and Palomino Insurance Agency Inc. shall immediately pay a civil penalty of seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) for deposit into the state general fund.
- Respondents are jointly and severally responsible for payment of the civil penalty.

- Respondents are aware of their right to notice and to a hearing, at which they
  may be represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses.

 Respondents irrevocably waive their right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent Order.

5. Respondents state that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to induce them to enter into this Consent Order and that they have entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

6. Respondents acknowledge that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against them and does not preclude any other agency, officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

7. Respondents acknowledge that this Consent Order is an administrative action that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC). Respondents further acknowledge that they must report this administrative action to any and all states in which they hold an insurance license and must disclose this administrative action on any license application.

8. Michael Joseph Palomino II represents that he is the President of Palomino Insurance Agency Inc., and, as such, is authorized to enter this Consent Order on its behalf.
