10	FINDINGS OF FACT	
11	1. Stonewood Insurance Company ("Respondent"), a foreign insurer domiciled in the	
12	State of North Carolina, has filed an application for a certificate of authority in the State of	
13	Arizona to transact casualty, marine & transportation, property, surety, and vehicle insurance.	
14	2. North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) § 58-5-5 requires a foreign domiciled	
15	fire and/or marine insurance company to make and maintain a \$100,000 deposit with North	
16	Carolina as a condition of transacting the business of insurance in North Carolina.	
17	3. North Carolina General Statute (N.C.G.S.) § 58-5-10 requires a foreign domiciled	
18	fidelity, surety, and casualty insurance company to make and maintain a \$200,000 deposit	
19	with North Carolina as a condition of transacting the business of insurance in North Carolina.	
20	4. N.C.G.S. § 58-5-90 requires the deposit to be held for the benefit of the holders of	
21	all insurance contracts of the insurance company who are citizens or residents of North	
22	Carolina.	
23	5. A.R.S. § 20-230(A) mandates the imposition of a retaliatory deposit.	
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1	CONCLUSIONS OF LAW	
2	1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.	
3	2. Grounds exist pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-230(A) for the Director to require the	
4	Respondent to make a retaliatory deposit with the State of Arizona.	
5	ORDER	
6	IT IS ORDERED requiring Respondent to, within 30 days of the date of this Order,	
7	deposit and maintain a retaliatory deposit in the amount of no less than \$300,000 with the	
8	State of Arizona for the sole benefit and protection of policyholders residing in Arizona and	
9	any risk that is resident, located or to be performed in Arizona, for as long as there is	
10	outstanding any liability of Respondent for which this deposit was required.
