

1 4. On January 27, 1995, the Director issued the
2 Notice of Hearing which was served upon Mr. Lev by mail at his
3 address of record with this Department.

4 5. Mr. Lev did not file an answer to the Notice of
5 Hearing and did not appear at the hearing of this matter.

6 6. In the Application, Mr. Lev disclosed that he had
7 been convicted of a misdemeanor and a felony.

8 7. On August 26, 1982, Mr. Lev was convicted in Los
9 Angeles, California, of the crime of vandalism, a violation of
10 California Penal Code 594(b), a felony.

11 8. On June 15, 1982, a jury found Mr. Lev guilty of
12 grand theft, grand theft auto, and burglary, all felonies. The
13 People of the State of California v. Robert Dennis Lev, Los
14 Angeles County Superior Court, Los Angeles, California, Case No.
15 A-147-255. Subsequently, the court entered judgment of
16 conviction against Mr. Lev for these offenses.

17 9. On November 27, 1991, Mr. Lev filed a Petition for
18 Certificate of Rehabilitation and Pardon with the Los Angeles
19 County Superior Court, Los Angeles, California.

20 10. On January 2, 1992, the Los Angeles County
21 Superior Court, Los Angeles, California, granted Mr. Lev's
22 Petition for Certificate of Rehabilitation. In the Matter of the
23 Application of Robert Dennis Lev For a Certificate of
24 Rehabilitation and Pardon, Case Nos. BA044559, A147225 and
25 A800605.

26 11. Mr. Lev had the burden of proof in the hearing of
27 this matter to establish his eligibility for the issuance of the
28 requested insurance license.

1 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

2 1. Mr. Lev received notice of this proceeding as
3 prescribed by A.R.S. §§20-163 and 41-1061.

4 2. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter
5 pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-142 and 20-316.

6 3. Mr. Lev did not meet his burden of proof and
7 failed to establish his eligibility for the issuance of the
8 requested insurance license.

9 4. Mr. Lev has a record of conviction by final
10 judgment of a felony involving moral turpitude within the meaning
11 of A.R.S. §20-290(B)(6).

14 Denying the application for a life insurance agent
15 license submitted by Applicant Robert Dennis Lev.
