






1 the State Treasurer for deposit in the State General Fund, to be  
2 provided to the Administrative Law Division of the Department of  
3 Insurance on or before the entry of this Order.

4  
5 4. CIGNA Dental Health and its agents and employees  
6 shall cease and desist from the transaction of insurance business  
7 as a prepaid dental plan organization in this state without a  
8 certificate of authority.

9  
10 5. CIGNA Dental Health shall, within 30 days from the  
11 date of this Order, submit evidence satisfactory to the Director  
12 of the payment of all outstanding Arizona premium tax obligations  
13 pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-1010 and 20-225 arising from CIGNA Dental  
14 Health's transactions as a prepaid dental plan organization. In  
15 addition, CIGNA Dental Health or its affiliates shall remit all  
16 outstanding premium tax obligations to the Department within 30  
17 days of this date of this Order or, if not yet due, on the due  
18 date established by law.

19  
20 6. This Order fully resolves all issues relating to  
21 the matters identified in this Consent Order regarding the  
22 transaction of insurance business as a prepaid dental plan  
23 organization in Arizona by CIGNA Dental Health or any of its  
24 affiliates without a certificate of authority issued by the  
25 Director of the Arizona Department of Insurance.

20 thereof from instituting other civil or criminal proceedings as  
21 may be appropriate now or in the future.

23 the office of Vice President - Secretary of CIGNA Dental  
24 Health is authorized to enter into this Consent Order for and on  
25 its behalf.
