On August 7, 1997, the Office of Administrative Hearings, through Administrative Law Judge Robert I. Worth, submitted a "Decision and Recommended Order" ("Recommended Order"), a copy of which is attached and incorporated by this reference. The Director of the Arizona Department of Insurance has reviewed the Recommended Order and enters the following order:

1. The recommended findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted.
2. The life and disability agent's license held by Robert Duane Bjerken is revoked.


NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

The aggrieved party may request a rehearing with respect to this Order by filing a written petition with the Office of Administrative Hearings within 30 days of the date of this Order, setting forth the basis for such relief pursuant to A.A.C. R20-6-114(B).

The final decision of the Director may be appealed to the Superior Court of Maricopa County for judicial review pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-166. A party filing an appeal must notify the Office of

1 Administrative Hearings of the appeal within ten days after filing the complaint commencing the appeal,
2 pursuant to A.R.S. §41-1092.10.

DECISION AND RECOMMENDED ORDER

8
9
10 The above-entitled matter came on for hearing on August 4, 1997 pursuant to
11 advance notice duly sent to all parties. The Arizona Department of Insurance (herein
12 called the "Department") was represented by Assistant Attorney General, Shelby L.
13 Cuevas, and the named Respondent, Robert Duane Bjerken, failed to appear.
14 Evidence was presented, and based upon the entire record, the following Findings of
15 Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommended Order have been prepared and are
16 hereby submitted by the undersigned Administrative Law Judge for review,
17 consideration, approval and adoption by the Director of the Department (herein called
18 the "Director").

19 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

20 1. The Department's uncontroverted evidence revealed that Respondent,
21 Robert Duane Bjerken, has been and is currently the holder of a life and disability
22 insurance agent's license, number 366523, issued by the Department.

23
24 2. The aforesaid insurance license has been repeatedly renewed by Mr. Bjerken
25 on successive occasions at two year intervals following the filing of renewal
26 applications. Since the renewal application filed on April 16, 1991, three separate
27 subsequent applications were completed and filed by Respondent, respectively dated
28 February 16, 1993, February 22, 1995 and March 8, 1997. The renewed license
29 presently held by Mr. Bjerken is due to expire on April 30, 1999.

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3. Each of the renewal application forms contained specific questions relating to events affecting an applicant which occurred since the last filed license application. Spaces were provided next to each question for the insertion of a "yes" or "no" response from the individual completing and submitting the application form.

4. The renewal application form filed by Respondent in 1993 (State's Exhibit 3), which was next in time to his previously filed 1991 renewal application, included as question number 4 the following:

"4. Since your last application or renewal thereof, have you had any professional, vocational, or business license denied, suspended, revoked, or restricted, or a fine imposed by any public authority, or withdrawn any application for or surrendered any such license to avoid disciplinary action?" (Emphasis added).

It was shown that Mr. Bjerken answered this question in the negative.

5. The documentary evidence presented at the hearing tended to establish that Mr. Bjerken had been one of the individual subjects of an Opinion and Order by the Arizona Corporation Commission in Docket Number S-2686-I (Decision No. 57401) entered on June 6, 1991 (State's Exhibit 5). This was less than two months after Respondent filed his 1991 application for renewal of his insurance license and approximately twenty months before the filing of his 1993 renewal. The said Opinion found Mr. Bjerken in violation of statutes prohibiting his offer and sale of unregistered securities in Arizona and without being registered as a salesman or dealer, as well as concluding the he had made such sales through material misrepresentations and omissions of material facts, constituting a fraud upon investors.

6. The 1991 final Order entered by the Arizona Corporation Commission provided for the assessment against Mr. Bjerken of an administrative penalty in the amount of \$7,000.00, for the joint and several obligation of Mr. Bjerken and others to make restitution to seven identified investors in the aggregate sum of \$67,000.00 and for Mr. Bjerken and others to Cease and Desist from engaging in certain described

1 activities involving the future sale of securities in this State. The foregoing
2 administrative proceeding and its results are determined to constitute data and
3 information that was required to be disclosed by Respondent on the 1993 application
4 form in response to question number 4.

5
6 7. The renewal application form filed by Respondent in 1997 (State's Exhibit 1),
7 which was next in time to his previously filed 1995 renewal application, included as
8 questions B and D the following:

9 "B. Have you had any professional, vocational, business license or
10 certification refused, denied, suspended, revoked or restricted, or a fine
11 imposed by any public authority that has not previously been disclosed by
12 you to this agency in a license application?

13

14 "D. Have you had any judgment, order or other determination, including
15 any criminal conviction issued or made against you in any criminal, civil,
16 administrative or other judicial or quasi-judicial proceeding of any kind in
17 any jurisdiction that has not previously been disclosed by you to this
18 agency in a license application based on any of the following:

- 19 1. Misappropriation, conversion or the withholding of monies?
- 20 2. Incompetence or a source of injury and/or loss to anyone?
- 21 3. Dishonesty in business or financial matters?
- 22 4. Fraud or misrepresentation?
- 23 5. Any cause arising out of an insurance transaction?"

24 (Emphasis added).

25 It was shown that Mr. Bjerken answered both of these questions in the negative.

26 8. The documentary evidence presented at the hearing tended to establish that
27 Mr. Bjerken had been one of the individual subjects of another Opinion and Order by
28 the Arizona Corporation Commission in Docket Number S-3976-I (Decision No. 59923)
29 entered December 18, 1996 (State's Exhibit 7). This was approximately twenty two

1 months after Respondent filed his 1995 application for renewal of his insurance license
2 and less than three months before the filing of his 1997 renewal application. The entry
3 of this Order had followed the sending to Respondent of a Notice of Opportunity for
4 Hearing with respect to the form and content of the proposed Order to be entered in
5 that case (State's Exhibit 6), to which notice Respondent had failed to respond or to
6 request any hearing, thereby admitting all allegations of wrongdoing. The said Opinion
7 found Mr. Bjerken in violation of statutes prohibiting his offer and sale of unregistered
8 securities in Arizona and without being registered as a salesman or dealer, as well as
9 concluding that he had made such sales through the making of material
10 misrepresentations to investors and further that his conduct operated as a fraud or
11 deceit upon investors.

12 9. The 1996 final Order entered by the Arizona Corporation Commission
13 provided for the assessment of an administrative penalty against Mr. Bjerken in the
14 amount of \$42,000.00, for his obligation to make restitution in the amount of
15 \$119,000.00, to be held in trust by the Arizona Attorney General's Office for distribution
16 to appropriate investors, and for Mr. Bjerken to Cease and Desist from engaging in
17 certain described activities involving future sales of securities in this State. The
18 foregoing administrative proceeding and its results are determined to constitute data or
19 information that was required to be disclosed by Mr. Bjerken on the 1997 application
20 form in response to questions B and D.

21 10. Except for a very minimal monetary sum of \$175.00 towards the restitution
22 ordered in the earlier proceeding before the Corporation Commission, Mr. Bjerken was
23 not shown to have paid all or any significant portion of his restitution obligations nor to
24 have paid any part of the administrative penalties assessed against him.

25 11. Under all the circumstances, including the proximity in time from the entry of
26 the Orders by the Corporation Commission to the filing of the next renewal application
27 for his insurance license, an inference is fully supportable that Mr. Bjerken's factually
28 incorrect answers to specific questions on the application forms, as well as his failure to
29 affirmatively disclose the rather serious findings of wrongdoing and the substantial
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1 sanctions imposed against him, was intentionally misleading and further constitute
2 material misrepresentations to the Department of Insurance.

3 12. The underlying actions, omissions and conduct on the part of Respondent
4 upon which the prior disciplinary proceedings before another State agency were based
5 are additionally found and determined to constitute a record of dishonesty in business
6 or financial matters.

7
8 13. By his failure to attend and participate in the scheduled hearing,
9 Respondent presented no evidence in defense or in mitigation of the insurance law
10 violations charged in the Notice of Hearing.

11 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

12
13 1. The Director of the Department has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to
14 the provisions of A.R.S. §§ 20-161 and 20-290.

15
16 2. The overall course of conduct on the part of or attributable to Mr. Bjerken
17 which formed the basis for final disciplinary Orders in two separate Corporation
18 Commission actions serve to constitute a record of dishonesty in business or financial
19 matters in violation by Respondent of the provisions of A.R.S. §20-290(B)(2).

20
21 3. The undisputed evidence of record sufficiently established that Mr. Bjerken's
22 actions in failing to disclose the facts and the results of two separate Corporation
23 Commission disciplinary proceedings adversely impacting upon him and in untruthfully
24 answering specific questions as to such facts on renewal applications filed with the
25 Department constitute willful misrepresentations of facts required to be disclosed to the
26 Department in violation by Respondent of A.R.S. §20-291(G).

27
28 4. The actions of Mr. Bjerken further constitute misrepresentation or fraud in
29 obtaining the renewal of his life and disability agent's insurance license and provide
30 grounds, pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-316(A)(3), and also A.R.S. §20-316(C), for the

1 Director to suspend, revoke or refuse to renew Respondent's license or to impose a
2 civil penalty against him.

3 5. The evidence of record did demonstrate that Mr. Bjerken failed to comply with
4 the provisions of two separate Orders of the Arizona Corporation Commission with
5 respect to imposed restitution obligations and administrative penalties, and in one
6 instance, the 1991 Order, with respect to ceasing and desisting from future securities
7 law violations. However, such acts or omissions by Mr. Bjerken did not constitute willful
8 violations or non-compliance with rules, regulations or orders of the director within the
9 meaning of the provisions of another statute charged in the Notice of Hearing as having
10 been violated by Respondent. The term "director" as used in the provisions of the
11 State's Insurance Laws is defined in A.R.S. §20-102 to indicate the director of the
12 Department of Insurance and may not properly be construed to include directors or
13 commissioners of other state or federal agencies. Consequently, no finding of any
14 violation by Respondent of A.R.S. §20-316(A)(2) is supportable hereunder.

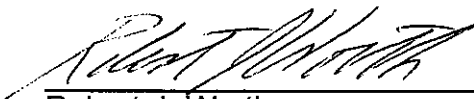
15 6. Under the proven facts and circumstances of this case, including Mr.
16 Bjerken's default in appearance at the scheduled hearing, the imposition by the
17 Director of a license revocation appears to be appropriate and fully warranted under
18 the totality of the evidence of record hereunder.

19 **RECOMMENDED ORDER**

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21 In view of the foregoing, it is recommended that the Director enter his Order
22 revoking the life and disability agent's license held by Robert Duane Bjerken.
