On May 29, 1998, the Office of Administrative Hearings, through Administrative Law Judge Casey J. Newcomb submitted Recommended Decision of the Administrative Law Judge ("Recommended Decision"), a copy of which is attached and incorporated by this reference. The Director of the Arizona Department of Insurance has reviewed the Recommended Decision and enters the following order:

- 1. The recommended findings of fact and conclusions of law are adopted.
- 2. The Petitioner is entitled to the release of its statutory deposit in the sum of \$100,000.00. The statutory deposit will be released to the Petitioner after the Department has received a fully executed Form E126 (Notice of Trust Deposit Release). The statutory deposit will not be released until the Department receives a fully executed copy of the official State Treasurer Release Receipt.
- 3. The sum of \$100.00 previously credited to the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund will be refunded to the Petitioner, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.

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NOTIFICATION OF RIGHTS

The aggrieved party may request a rehearing with respect to this Order by filing a written petition with the Office of Administrative Hearings within 30 days of the date of this Order, setting forth the basis for such relief pursuant to A.A.C. R20-6-114(B).

The final decision of the Director may be appealed to the Superior Court of Maricopa County for judicial review pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-166. A party filing an appeal must notify the Office of Administrative Hearings of the appeal within ten days after filing the complaint commencing the appeal, pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.10.

On May 28, 1998, a hearing took place to consider the application of Advantage Life Insurance Company (the "Petitioner") that was filed with the Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") for the release of its statutory deposit pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-581, 20-588 and A.A.C. R20-6-303.

Based upon the entire record in this matter, the following Recommended Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommended Order are made:

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Petitioner has filed its certified financial statement as of December 31, 1997, and a Plan of Extinguishment of Liabilities with the Department.
- 2. At least 10 business days prior to this hearing, Petitioner gave special notice to its creditors and policyholders setting forth the date, place, nature and purpose of this hearing. See Petitioner's Exhibits 4 & 5.

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- 3. The Petitioner has a \$100,000.00 statutory deposit with the Department.
- 4. The Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF").
- 5. The Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. §20-588 and A.A.C. R20-6-303 relating to the release of its \$100,000.00 statutory deposit.
- 6. Petitioner currently owes \$0.00 to the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF"). See Petitioner's Exhibit 7.

RECOMMENDED ORDER

The undersigned Administrative Law Judge recommends that:

- 1. The Petitioner is entitled to the release of its statutory deposit in the sum of \$100,000.00 and that the statutory deposit shall be released to the Petitioner after the Department has received a fully executed Form E126 (Notice of Trust Deposit Release). The statutory deposit cannot be released until the Department receives a fully executed copy of the official State Treasurer Release Receipt.
- 2. The sum of \$100.00 previously credited to the IERF shall be refunded to the Petitioner, pursuant to A.R.S. §20-159.
