CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Richard Jacob Wallum, ("Respondent") violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of Fact are true and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Richard Jacob Wallum is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident accident/life/health producer, Arizona license number 271750, which license expires April 30, 2009.

2. On or about July 15, 2005, Respondent called a prospective client in follow up to a "lead" card and left a voice mail message stating that he was with the Arizona Department of Insurance. Respondent is not now nor has he ever been employed by the Arizona Department of Insurance.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.
2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-295(A)(2).

1 3. Respondent is aware of his right to notice and a hearing at which he may be
2 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent irrevocably
3 waives his right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent
4 Order.

5 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
6 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this
7 Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

8 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
9 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,
10 officer, or subdivision of this state from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be
11 appropriate now or in the future.
