

1 4. Petitioner has no insurance obligations.

2 5. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners'
3 Revolving Fund ("IERF").

4 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and
6 Title 20, Chapter 4, Article 14 relating to the surrender of its Certificate
7 of Authority and its withdrawal from the insurance business.

8 ORDER

9 1. Petitioner's request to terminate its Certificate of Authority is
10 granted.

11 2. Petitioner may file its Articles of Dissolution with the Arizona
12 Corporation Commission.

13 3. Petitioner shall forward a copy of Petitioner's Articles of
14 Dissolution certified as having been filed with the Arizona Corporation
15 Commission.

16 4. The sum of \$100.00 previously credited to the IERF shall be
17 refunded to the Petitioner, pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
