**ORDER RELEASING
DEPOSIT**

Arizona Revised Statutes § 20-588(A)(2) provides that deposited funds shall be released upon application to and written Order of the Director and returned to the Petitioner to the extent that such deposit is in excess of the amount required.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Vanliner Insurance Company ("Petitioner"), was an Arizona domiciled insurer known as Great Southwest Fire Insurance Company when it received its certificate of authority to transact casualty including workers' compensation, disability, marine and transportation, property, surety and vehicle insurance in Arizona effective April 1, 1954.

2. Petitioner established and continuously maintained a deposit of at least \$500,000 (Five hundred thousand dollars) with the Arizona State Treasurer for the protection of all of its policyholders within the United States in accordance with A.R.S. §§ 20-213 and 20-582.

3. Effective September 24, 1986, Petitioner changed its name to Vanliner Insurance Company.

4. Effective November 1, 2005, Petitioner redomesticated to Missouri and terminated the authority to transact surety and disability insurance in Arizona.
