

1 3. On November 21 2005, the Insurance Commissioner of Oregon approved the
2 merger of Petitioner into SICH.

3 4. Petitioner has no obligations under any policy of insurance to any
4 policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.

5 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct
6 examination, and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

7 6. The Department holds a Workers' Compensation deposit in the amount of
8 \$126,000 on behalf of the Petitioner.

9 IT IS ORDERED that:

10 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

11 2. The Workers' Compensation deposit of the Petitioner in the amount of
12 \$126,000 shall be transferred to an account in the name of SICH with the Department,
13 and shall be held as a Workers' Compensation deposit of SICH.
