**ORDER SUMMARILY SUSPENDING
BAIL BOND AGENT LICENSE
AND NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY
FOR HEARING**

The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") alleges that **Brian Paul Spielman** has violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."), Title 20. In light of the serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of Arizona ("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action, within the meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Brian Paul Spielman ("Respondent") is licensed as a bail bond agent, Arizona License Number 850172 which expires on July 31, 2009.

2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: c/o Better Bail Bonds, 3116 N. Scottsdale Rd., Scottsdale, Arizona 85251 (business); 1500 E. Broadway, #2006, Tempe, Arizona 85282 (residence).

2. On May 4, 2006, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified the Department and Respondent (at an incorrect address) that Respondent's bail agent bond was to be cancelled in 30 days.

1 3. On or about June 4, 2006, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond
2 cancelled Respondent's bail agent bond.

3 4. As of June 4, 2006, the Respondent has not maintained a bond in favor of this
4 State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State.

5 5. On July 6, 2006, the Department notified Respondent at his business address of
6 record, return receipt requested, that his surety bond had been cancelled.

7 6. The Department's July 6, 2006 letter to Respondent's business address of
8 record was signed by someone at Respondent's business address of record.

9 7. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

10 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

11 1. The Director has jurisdiction.

12 2. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of the requirement that each bail
13 bond agent maintain in force while license a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety
14 insurer authorized to do business in this State, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.02.

15 3. Grounds exist to order a summary suspension within the meaning of A.R.S. §
16 41-1092.11(B).

17 **ORDER**

18 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

19 1. Respondent's license is summarily suspended effective immediately.
