**ORDER DENYING REQUEST
FOR REHEARING**

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On December 7, 2006, the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") filed a Notice of Hearing ("Notice") in the above captioned matter with the Office of Administrative Hearings ("OAH"). The Notice stated that Petitioners were required to file a written Answer with the Department within twenty (20) days after issuance of the Notice to avoid being deemed in Default.

2. A copy of the Notice was served upon Petitioners at Steven Craig Bond's business address of record by certified mail¹.

3. On December 11, 2006, the post office delivered a certified mail return receipt to the Department showing that the Notice had been delivered and accepted at Steven Craig Bond's business address of record on December 8, 2006.

4. Petitioners failed to file a written Answer on or before December 27, 2006 or at any time thereafter.

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
- 3. Accident or surprise which could not have been prevented by ordinary prudence;
- 4. Newly discovered material evidence which could not have been discovered with reasonable diligence and produced at the hearing;
- 5. Excessive or insufficient sanctions or penalties imposed;
- 6. Error in the admission or rejection of evidence, or errors of law occurring at the hearing or during the course of the hearing;
- 7. Bias or prejudice of the Director or hearing officer;
- 8. That the order, decision, or findings of fact are not justified by the evidence or are contrary to law.

4. The Director has reviewed Petitioner's Motion for Re-Hearing Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-1092.09 and the Department's Response to Motion for Rehearing and finds that Petitioner has not established a ground upon which to grant a rehearing pursuant to A.A.C. R20-6-114.

ORDER

1. Petitioner's Request for Rehearing is denied.

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
