2 policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.

3 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct
4 examination, and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

5 6. Petitioner has deposited \$100.00 which has been credited to the
6 Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF") pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.

7 IT IS ORDERED that:

- 8 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.
- 9 2. The \$100.00 deposited by Petitioner which has been credited to the IERF
10 shall be released to Petitioner.
