13 Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the  
14 Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, the  
15 Director finds as follows:

16 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

17 1. Petitioner, United Americas Insurance Company, NAIC No. 36285, is a  
18 foreign insurer domiciled in New York. Petitioner received its certificate of authority to  
19 transact property and casualty insurance in Arizona on January 18, 1983.

20 2. Petitioner seeks to withdraw from the insurance business in Arizona and has  
21 voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Director.

22 3. Petitioner has no obligations under any policy of insurance to any  
23 policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.

24 4. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct  
25 examination.

1 5. Petitioner's 2008 Annual Tax and Fees Report and 2008 Annual Statement  
2 together with payment of all applicable fees is due to this Department March 1, 2009.

3 6. Petitioner has deposited \$100.00 which has been credited to the Insurance  
4 Examiners' Revolving Fund ("IERF") pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.

5 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

6 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C.  
7 R20-6-303, relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority and its withdrawal from  
8 the insurance business.

9 **ORDER**

- 10 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.  
11 2. Petitioner shall file its 2008 Annual Tax and Fees Report and 2008 Annual  
12 Statement, together with payment of all applicable fees.  
13 3. The \$100.00 deposited by Petitioner which has been credited to the IERF  
14 shall be released to Petitioner.
