**FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF
LAW AND ORDER**

On June 9, 2009, the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") issued a Notice of Hearing ("Notice") in the above-captioned matter. A copy of the Notice is attached and incorporated by this reference. The Notice required Respondent to provide a written answer to the allegations set forth in the Notice within twenty (20) days of the issuance. The twenty (20) day deadline for the filing of Respondent's answer to the Notice elapsed on June 29, 2009. As of this date, Respondent has failed to file an answer to the Notice.

On July 13, 2009, counsel for the Department filed a Request for Default. As of this date Respondent has not responded to the Department's request. Pursuant to A.A.C. R20-6-106(D), a party that fails to file an answer within the time provided shall be deemed to be in default and one or more of the allegations in the Notice of Hearing may be deemed to be admitted.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Notice was proper.
2. Respondent is in default.
3. The allegations in the Notice and Amended Notice are deemed admitted.

1 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

2 1. Angulo's conduct, as described above, constitutes using fraudulent, coercive
3 or dishonest practices, or demonstrating incompetence, untrustworthiness or financial
4 irresponsibility in the conduct of business in this state or elsewhere, in violation of A.R.S. §
5 20-295(A)(8).

6 2. Angulo's conduct, as described above, constitutes having an insurance
7 producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended or revoked in any state, province,
8 district or territory, in violation of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(9).

9 3. Grounds exist for the Director to revoke, or refuse to renew Angulo's
10 insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 20-
11 295(A) and (F).

12 ORDER

13 1. Respondent's insurance producer license is revoked, effective upon the
14 issuance of this Order.

15 2. The hearing set for July 29, 2009, at 1:30 p.m. before Administrative Law
16 Judge, Thomas Shedden shall be vacated.
