ORDER TO CEASE
AND DESIST

The Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that Respondents have unlawfully solicited insurance in the State of Arizona. Accordingly, the Director of Insurance of the State of Arizona (the "Director") makes the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and enters the following Order pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-292.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Starway Agency, Inc. ("Respondent Starway" or "Starway") is, and was at all times material, a New York domestic corporation licensed as a resident property and casualty agent, New York license # PC-1006444, which expires on June 30, 2010, and a New York resident broker, New York license # BR-1006444, which expires on October 31, 2010. Starway is also licensed in Maryland as a non-resident property and casualty producer, Maryland license # NPF 99999139, which expires on May 28, 2010.

2. Starway is not licensed as an insurance producer in the State of Arizona.

3. Starway is not exempt from the licensing requirement.

4. Starway's address of record is: 334 E. 92nd Street, Suite 1C, New York, New York 10128.

5. Shelley Chang ("Respondent Chang" or "Chang") is, and was at all times material, a non-resident property and casualty producer, Arizona license # 949827, which expires on July 31, 2013.

1 **ORDER**

2 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

3 1. Respondents shall immediately cease and desist from soliciting any class or
4 classes of insurance in this state until such time that Respondent Starway is licensed for
5 the appropriate line of authority.

6 2. This Order shall become effective immediately and shall remain in full force
7 and effect until otherwise stayed, modified, vacated or set aside.

8 **NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING**

9 Pursuant to Title 20 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, Respondents are hereby
10 notified that they may request a hearing pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-161 to contest the order to
11 cease and desist. Such a request must be in writing and received at the following address
12 within thirty (30) days from the date hereof:
