CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Shull and Associates, LLC and Bradley Ronald Shull ("Respondents")** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondents wish to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of Fact are true and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Shull and Associates, LLC ("S&A") is an Arizona domestic limited liability company incorporated on March 13, 2008. S&A's address of record is: 2244 W. Twain Dr., Anthem, Arizona 85086.

2. Bradley Ronald Shull ("Shull") is, and was at all times material, an Arizona licensed adjuster, Arizona license number 875107 which expires on July 31, 2010. Shull is the sole Member of S&A.

3. S&A is not licensed as an adjuster in the State of Arizona.

4. S&A is not exempt from the licensing requirement.

5. On October 23, 2009, the State Bar of Arizona forwarded a complaint to the Department which included copies of correspondence signed by Shull holding S&A out as "Adjusters and Attorneys."

1 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

2 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

3 2. S&A is not exempt from the licensing requirement, within the meaning of A.R.S.
4 § 20-321(B).

5 3. S&A's conduct, as described above, constitutes acting as or claiming to be an
6 adjuster without being licensed as an adjuster, in violation of A.R.S. § 20-321.01(A).

7 4. Shull's conduct, as described above, constitutes a violation of Title 20, within the
8 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(2).

9 5. Grounds exist to issue a cease and desist order to S&A for acting as or claiming
10 to be an adjuster without being licensed, within the meaning of A.R.S. §§ 20-321.02 and 20-
11 292.

12 6. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke or refuse to renew Shull's
13 adjuster license pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-321.02, 20-295(A) and (B).

14 7. Grounds exist for the Director to, in addition to or instead of any suspension,
15 revocation or refusal to renew, impose a civil penalty of not more than more than \$250 for
16 each unintentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate penalty of \$2,500, or impose a civil
17 penalty of not more than \$2500 for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate
18 penalty of \$15,000, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(F).

19 **ORDER**

20 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT

21 1. S&A shall cease and desist from unlawfully acting as or claiming to be an
22 adjuster until it is properly licensed by the Department as an adjuster.
