CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Harold Gil** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Harold Gil ("Gil" or "Respondent") is, and was at all material times, licensed by the Department as an Arizona resident property and casualty producer, Arizona license number 909311, which expires on September 30, 2011.

2. Gil's address of record with the Department is: 2630 N. 86th Dr., Phoenix, Arizona 85037 (residence, business and mailing).

3. On May 2, 2008, the Superior Court of the State, In and for the County of Maricopa, entered an order in CR2007-153293-002-DT convicting Harold Gil of negligent homicide, a class 4 dangerous felony.

4. Gil did not report the criminal conviction to the Department within 30 days.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

1 2. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Director of Insurance, State of
2 Arizona, and admits the foregoing Findings of Fact and consents to the entry of the
3 foregoing Conclusions of Law and Order.

4 3. Respondent is aware of his right to notice and a hearing at which he may be
5 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent
6 irrevocably waives his right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to
7 this Consent Order.

8 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except
9 as expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into
10 this Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

11 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
12 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,
13 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
14 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

15 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
16 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
17 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to
18 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this
19 administrative action on any license application.
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
21 7. Respondent acknowledges that failure to comply with the terms of this

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1 further action by the Department, including criminal action, or referral of this matter by the
2 Department to another federal or state agency.
