

ORDER

Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Globe American Casualty Company ("Petitioner") is an Ohio domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact property and casualty insurance in Arizona effective July 25, 1973.

2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into The Midwestern Indemnity Company (MIC), NAIC No. 23515, the surviving entity, an Ohio domiciled insurer effective December 30, 2009. MIC is not authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.

3. The Insurance Commissioner of Ohio approved the merger of Petitioner into MIC on December 14, 2009.

4. Petitioner has no insurance obligations under any policy of insurance to any policyholders or claimants who are residents of Arizona.

5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

1 6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund
2 ("IERF").

3 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**


4 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-
5 303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.

6 **ORDER**

7 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

8 2. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the sum of \$100.00 that was
9 previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
