The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Arlene Leonor Woolfolk** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Arlene Leonor Woolfolk ("Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident accident/health and life producer, Arizona license number 941144 which expires March 31, 2013.
2. Respondent's mailing, business and residence addresses of record with the Department are: 10205 E. Essex Village Dr., Tucson, Arizona 85748 (business, mailing and residence).
3. On or about April 1, 2009, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a resident accident/health and life producer, Arizona license number 941144.
4. On September 1, 2009, the Department notified Respondent by mail at her business/ mailing/ residence address of record that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before October 2, 2009.

CONSENT TO ORDER

2 1. Respondent has reviewed the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law
3 and Order.

4 2. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Director of Insurance, State of
5 Arizona, and admits the foregoing Findings of Fact and consents to the entry of the foregoing
6 Conclusions of Law and Order.

7 3. Respondent is aware of her right to notice and a hearing at which she may be
8 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent irrevocably
9 waives her right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent
10 Order.

11 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
12 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to her to induce her to enter into this
13 Consent Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.


14 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
15 Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency,
16 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
17 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

18 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
19 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
20 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that she must report this administrative action to
