**ORDER SUMMARILY SUSPENDING
LIFE AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATOR
CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION
AND NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY
FOR HEARING**

9 The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") alleges that **Ben-E-Lect**
 10 **Corporation** has violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."), Title 20. In light
 11 of the serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of Arizona
 12 ("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency
 13 action, within the meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B).

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 15 1. Ben-E-Lect Corporation ("Respondent") holds a certificate of registration as a life
 16 and health administrator in Arizona.
 - 17 2. Respondent's address of record with the Department is: P.O. Box 7809, 5429
 18 Avenida De Los Robles, #A, Visalia, California 93291-7809.
 - 19 3. On November 29, 2010, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified
 20 the Department that Respondent's life and health administrator bond was to be cancelled in
 21 30 days or on December 29, 2010.
 - 22 4. As of December 29, 2010, Respondent has not maintained a bond in favor of
 23 this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State.

1 5. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

2 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

3 1. The Director has jurisdiction.

4 2. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of the requirement that each
5 administrator possess and maintain a surety bond in a form acceptable to the director and
6 issued by a corporate surety authorized to transact business in this State, within the meaning
7 of A.R.S. § 20-485.10.

8 3. Grounds exist to order a summary suspension within the meaning of A.R.S. §
9 41-1092.11(B).

10 **ORDER**

11 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

12 1. Respondent's life and health administrator certificate of registration is summarily
13 suspended effective immediately.
