CONSENT ORDER

Respondents.

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Respondents** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondents wish to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admit the following Findings of Fact are true and consent to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jerrold Dwayne Boudreaux ("Respondent Boudreaux ") is, and was at all material times licensed as an Arizona resident property, casualty, accident/health and life insurance producer, license number 94578, which expires on October 31, 2013.
2. Boudreauxs Arizona Insurance Services is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident property, casualty, accident/health and life insurance producer, license number 180696, which expires on July 31, 2014. Respondent Boudreaux is the Managing Partner and Designated Responsible Licensed Producer for Boudreauxs Arizona Insurance Services.

1 3. On or about November 2, 2004, Respondents contracted with Safeco Insurance
2 Company ("Safeco") to transact property and casualty insurance on its behalf in Arizona.

3 4. Between March 2007 and August 2010, Respondents created thirteen (13)
4 fictitious certificates of insurance and submitted them to Safeco as evidence of prior coverage
5 in order that their clients could receive a favorable premium rating for their automobile
6 insurance.

7 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

8 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

9 2. Respondents' conduct as described above constitutes intentionally
10 misrepresenting the terms of an actual or proposed insurance contract or application for
11 insurance, within the meaning of A.R.S. §20-295(A)(5).

12 3. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
13 Respondents' insurance licenses, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to
14 A.R.S. §§20-295(A), (B) and (F).

15 **ORDER**

16 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

17 1. Respondent Boudreaux's license is suspended for thirty (30) days, effective
18 immediately upon entry of this Order.

19 2. Respondents shall pay a civil penalty of \$5,000.00 for deposit into the State
20 General Fund within thirty (30) days of the effective date of this order.

21 3. Respondents are jointly and severally responsible for payment of the civil
22 penalty.

1 **CONSENT TO ORDER**

4 2. Respondents admit the jurisdiction of the Director of Insurance, State of Arizona,
5 and admit the foregoing Findings of Fact and consent to the entry of the foregoing
6 Conclusions of Law and Order.

7 3. Respondents are aware of their right to notice and a hearing at which they may
8 be represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondents
9 irrevocably waive their right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this
10 Consent Order.

11 4. Respondents state that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
12 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to them to induce them to enter into this
13 Consent Order and that they have entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

14 5. Respondents acknowledge that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
15 Director is solely to settle this matter against them and does not preclude any other agency,
16 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
17 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

18 6. Respondents acknowledge that this Consent Order is an administrative action
19 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC)



2 either to the Department or other states' Departments of Insurance.


3 7. Jerrold Dwayne Boudreaux represents that he is Managing Partner of
