CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Jason Seth Fine** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes.

Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Jason Seth Fine ("Fine" or "Respondent") is licensed with the Department as an Arizona resident accident/health, life, variable life/variable annuities, property and casualty producer, Arizona license number 885932, which expires on July 31, 2014.

2. Respondent's addresses of record are: 18700 N. 107<sup>th</sup> Ave., #31, Sun City, Arizona 85373 (business and mailing); and 17926 W. San Juan Ave., Litchfield Park, Arizona 85340 (residence).

3. On or about April 19, 2011, Brian Hazlett ("Hazlett") filed a Complaint with the Department alleging that Fine initiated a renter's insurance policy and debited Hazlett's bank account for premium amounts without Hazlett's authorization. Fine had previously secured an automobile insurance policy for Hazlett.



1 than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) for each intentional failure or violation, up to  
2 an aggregate civil penalty of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-295(F)

5 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

6 1. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty of one hundred dollars (\$100) due  
7 immediately upon entry of this order for deposit into the State General Fund.

1           4.       Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as  
2 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this  
3 Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

4           5.       Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the  
5 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,  
6 including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting civil  
7 or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

8           6.       Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action  
9 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners  
10 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to  
11 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative  
12 action on any license application.
