ORDER

Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant  
Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance  
("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Landmark Insurance Company ("Petitioner") is a California domiciled insurance  
company that received its certificate of authority to transact property and casualty insurance in  
Arizona effective November 29, 1984.

2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into National Union Fire Insurance  
Company of Pittsburgh, PA. (NUFIC), NAIC No. 19445, the surviving entity, a Pennsylvania  
domiciled insurer effective January 1, 2012. NUFIC is authorized to transact insurance in  
Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.

3. The Insurance Commissioner of California approved the merger of Petitioner into  
NUFIC on January 10, 2012.

1 4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether  
2 written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are  
3 residents of this State.

4 5. Petitioner is not the subject of any pending investigation or market conduct  
5 examination and Petitioner does not owe this Department any filings or fees.

6 6. Petitioner has a \$100.00 deposit with the Insurance Examiners' Revolving Fund  
7 ("IERF").

### 8 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW


9 Petitioner has complied with the provisions of A.R.S. § 20-217 and with A.A.C. R20-6-  
10 303 relating to the surrender of its Certificate of Authority.

### 11 ORDER

12 1. The surrender of the Petitioner's certificate of authority is accepted.

13 2. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the sum of \$100.00 that was  
14 previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
