CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Randolph & Co Bail Bonds, Inc.** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Randolph & Co Bail Bonds, Inc. ("Respondent" or "Randolph & Co") is, and at all times material was, licensed as a resident bail bond agent, Arizona license number 145821 which expires on January 31, 2015.

2. Respondent's address of record with the Department is: 49 S. Mesa Dr., Mesa, Arizona 85210 (business and mailing).

3. Tony Ann Randolph, Arizona license number 1454773, is the President and Designated Responsible Licensed Producer for Randolph & Co.

4. On or about March 23, 2012, Yolanda Reyes ("Reyes") filed a Request for Assistance with the Department ("Complaint").

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1           3.       Respondent is aware of its right to notice and hearing at which it may be  
2 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent irrevocably  
3 waives its right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent  
4 Order.

5           4.       Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except  
6 as expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to it to induce it to enter into this  
7 Consent Order and that it has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.


8           5.       Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the  
9 Director is solely to settle this matter against it and does not preclude any other agency,  
10 including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting  
11 civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

12           6.       Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action  
13 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners  
14 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that it must report this administrative action to  
15 any and all states in which it holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative  
16 action on any license application.

17           7.       Tony Ann Randolph represents that she is the President of Randolph & Co Bail  
18 Bonds, Inc. and, as such, is authorized to enter this Consent Order on its behalf.
