**ORDER SUMMARILY SUSPENDING
BAIL BOND AGENT LICENSE
AND NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY
FOR HEARING**

(Arizona License # 145356))

(National Producer # 7541635))

The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") alleges that **Ralph Cooper Randolph** has violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."), Title 20. In light of the serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of Arizona ("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action, within the meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Ralph Cooper Randolph ("Respondent") is licensed as a resident bail bond agent, Arizona license number 145356, which expires on July 31, 2016.
2. Respondent's addresses of record are: c/o Randolph Bail Bonds, Inc., 49 S. Mesa Dr., Mesa, Arizona 85210 (business and mailing); 1628 E. Hampton Ave., Mesa, Arizona 85204 (residence).
3. On August 31, 2011, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified the Department that Respondent's bail agent bond was to be cancelled, effective 30 days from the date of the notice.

1 4. On September 10, 2011, the Department notified Respondent that the surety
2 holding Respondent's bond was cancelling the bond effective October 30, 2011.

3 5. To date, Respondent has failed to replace the cancelled surety bond.

4 6. Therefore, as of October 30, 2011, Respondent has not maintained a bond in
5 favor of this State executed by a surety insurer authorized to do business in this State.

6 7. The public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action.

7 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

8 1. The Director has jurisdiction.

9 2. Respondent's conduct constitutes a violation of the requirement that each bail
10 bond agent maintain in force while license a bond in favor of this State executed by a surety
11 insurer authorized to do business in this State, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-340.02.


12 3. Grounds exist to order a summary suspension within the meaning of A.R.S. §
13 41-1092.11(B).

14 **ORDER**

15 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

16 1. Respondent's bail bond agent license, Arizona license number 145356, is
17 summarily suspended effective immediately.
