The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Mark Lee Tabaka dba A & A Bail Bonds** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.


FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Mark Lee Tabaka dba A & A Bail Bonds ("Tabaka" or Respondent") is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident bail bond agent, Arizona license number 933622, which expires on July 31, 2016¹.
2. Tabaka's address of record with the Department is: 648 E. Main St., Mesa, Arizona 85203 (business, mailing and residence).
3. Between or about May 2, 2012, through June 6, 2013, Respondent comingled funds from his Bank America collateral account to pay bills, make cash withdrawals, and transfer money to his business and personal bank accounts.

¹ Respondent also uses the dba "Mesa Bail Bonds" which is not registered with the Department but is registered with the Arizona Secretary of State.

1 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
2 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners (NAIC)
3 and that he may have to report this administrative action on any future licensing applications
4 either to the Department or other states' Departments of Insurance.


