CONSENT ORDER

Respondent.

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Sarah Anne Hosman ("Respondent")** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health, life, casualty, and property insurance producer, Arizona license number 181718, which expires February 28, 2014.

2. Respondent's addresses of record are: 123 N. Centennial Way #228, Mesa, Arizona 85201 (business and mailing) and 29 N. Edgemont St., Mesa, Arizona 85203 (residence).

3. Respondent was at all material times contracted with MetLife Auto & Home Insurance ("MetLife") to transact insurance on its behalf in Arizona.

4. On or about May 20, 2013, Respondent forged and submitted a Payroll Authorization form to MetLife for the issuance of policy #990580566-0.

1 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

2 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

3 2. Respondent's conduct as described above, constitutes forging another's name
4 to any document related to an insurance transaction, within the meaning or A.R.S. § 20-295
5 (A)(10).

6 3. Grounds exist for the Director to deny, suspend for not more than twelve months,
7 revoke, or refuse to renew an insurance producer's license, impose a civil penalty and/or order
8 restitution pursuant to A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

9 **ORDER**

10 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

11 1. Respondent shall immediately pay a civil penalty of \$250.00 for deposit into the
12 State General Fund.


1 3. Respondent is aware of her right to notice and hearing at which she may be
2 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent irrevocably
3 waives her right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to this Consent
4 Order.

5 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as
6 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to her to induce them to enter into this
7 Consent Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

8 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
9 Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency,
10 including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting civil
11 or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

12 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
13 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
14 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to
15 any and all states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this
16 administrative action on any license application.
