The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **George Harbison** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. George Harbison ("Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident personal lines (P&C) producer, Arizona license number 1027154, which expires May 31, 2016.

2. Respondent's mailing, business, and residence addresses of record with the Department are: (mailing and residence) 1239 E. Eugie Avenue, Phoenix, Arizona 85022 and (business) One Norterra Drive, Phoenix, Arizona 85085.

3. On or about September 5, 2012, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a resident personal lines (P&C) producer, Arizona license number 1027154.

4. On December 24, 2012, the Department notified Respondent by mail at his mailing/residence address of record that his fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement

1 Form" on or before January 31, 2013. The Respondent did not reply to the Department's
2 request.

3 5. On May 2, 2013, the Department notified Respondent a second time by mail at
4 his residence address of record that it was about to initiate an administrative action against his
5 license for failure to comply with the fingerprint requirement. The Department requested a
6 response by May 15, 2013.

7 6. To date, Respondent has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the
8 Department.

9 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

10 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

11 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the
12 requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the
13 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(E)(2).

14 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete
15 information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).

16 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any
17 provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of
18 A.R.S. §20-295(A)(2).

19 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew
20 Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to
21 A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

22 ORDER

23 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent shall immediately submit his fingerprints and an Illegible Fingerprint
Replacement Form to the Department.


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1 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
2 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
3 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to
4 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative
5 action on any license application.
