ORDER

Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant
Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance
("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Kansas Bankers Surety Company ("Petitioner") is a Kansas domiciled
insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact casualty and surety
insurance in Arizona effective March 3, 1997.

2. Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Berkshire Hathaway Homestate
Insurance Company (BHHIC), NAIC No. 20044, the surviving entity, a Nebraska domiciled
insurer effective December 31, 2013. BHHIC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona.
Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.

3. The Insurance Commissioner of Kansas approved the merger of Petitioner into
BHHIC on December 11, 2013.

4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether
written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are
residents of this State.
