CONSENT ORDER

Respondent.

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Christie Peterson ("Respondent")** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about March 21, 2014, Respondent submitted a Resident License Application with the Department ("Application") to be licensed as a bail bond agent.
2. Respondent's mailing, business and residence addresses are: 2118 E. Aspen Ave., Mesa, Arizona 85204 (mailing and residence) and 49 S. Mesa Dr., Mesa, Arizona 85210 (business).
3. The Background Questions of the Application ask: 1. Have you ever been convicted of a misdemeanor, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a misdemeanor? You may exclude the following misdemeanor convictions or pending misdemeanor charges: traffic citations, driving under the influence (DUI), driving while intoxicated (DWI), driving without a license, reckless driving, or driving with a suspended or revoked license. You may also exclude juvenile adjudications (offenses where you were adjudicated delinquent in a juvenile court). Respondent answered "No" to this question.

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ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent shall immediately pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$100.00 for deposit into the State General Fund.

Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency, officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.
