ORDER

- 1. Petitioner's request to terminate its Certificate of Authority is granted.
- 2. Petitioner may file its Articles of Dissolution with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC").
- 3. Petitioner shall provide the Department with an ACC certified copy of Petitioner's ACC filed Articles of Dissolution.
- 4. Petitioner shall pay its Certificate of Authority renewal fee to the Department unless it files Articles of Dissolution with the ACC on or before March 31, 2015.
- 5. Petitioner shall file its 2015 Annual Report with the Department unless it files Articles of Dissolution with the ACC on or before December 31, 2015.
- 6. The Department shall refund to the Petitioner the \$100.00 that was previously credited to the IERF pursuant to A.R.S. § 20-159.
