CONSENT ORDER

Respondent.

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Jason Alonso Patterson** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jason Alonso Patterson ("Patterson" or "Respondent") is, and was at all material times, licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health, life, casualty and property insurance producer, Arizona license number 917685, which expires on May 31, 2015.

2. Patterson's address of record is: 55 S. Hwy 92, Ste. E., Sierra Vista, Arizona 85635 (business and mailing).

3. Patterson was at all material times contracted with American Family Insurance ("American Family") as an agent to transact insurance on their behalf in Arizona.

4. On or about August 6, 2014, American Family made a fraud referral with the Department alleging that Patterson had misappropriated premium monies.


1 **ORDER**

2 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

3 1. Respondent's license (Arizona number 917685) is revoked effective immediately
4 upon entry of this Order.

5 2. Respondent shall immediately make restitution to American Family in the amount
6 of \$1,051.00.
