**ORDER SUMMARILY SUSPENDING  
BAIL BOND AGENT LICENSE AND  
NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR  
HEARING**

The Arizona Department of Insurance (the "Department") alleges that **Debra Sue Schoen** has violated provisions of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."), Title 20. In light of the serious nature of these allegations, the Director of Insurance for the State of Arizona ("Director") finds that the public health, safety and welfare imperatively require emergency action, within the meaning of A.R.S. §41-1092.11(B).

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Debra Sue Schoen ("Respondent") is licensed as a resident bail bond agent, Arizona license number 1032396, which expires on September 30, 2016.
2. Respondent's address of record is: 52 S. Mesa Dr., Mesa, Arizona 85210 (business and mailing).
3. On October 14, 2014, the insurer holding Respondent's surety bond notified the Department that Respondent's bail agent bond was to be cancelled, effective 30 days after the Department's receipt of the notice.
4. On October 20, 2014, the Department notified Respondent that the surety holding Respondent's bond was cancelling the bond effective November 14, 2014.


9 Upon receipt of a timely written request for hearing, the Director will issue an order
