The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **CHRISTINE D. GLUZINSKI** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Christine D. Gluzinski ("Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident property and casualty producer, Arizona license number 1101452, which expires November 30, 2018.
2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: 9275 E. Caribbean Lane, Scottsdale, AZ 85260 and 2512 W. Dunlap Ave., Phoenix, AZ 85021 (mailing and business).
3. On or about January 15, 2015, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a resident property and casualty producer, Arizona license number 1101452.
4. On June 12, 2015, the Department notified Respondent by mail at her address of record that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of

1 fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before July  
2 13, 2015. Respondent did not reply to the Department's request.

3 5. On July 31, 2015, the Department notified Respondent a second time by mail at  
4 her address of record that her fingerprints had been returned by DPS as illegible and that the  
5 Department was about to initiate an administrative action against her license for failure to  
6 comply with the fingerprint requirement. The Department requested a response by August 24,  
7 2015.

8 6. To date, Respondent has not submitted a full set of fingerprints to the  
9 Department.

### 10 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

11 1. The Director has jurisdiction over this matter.

12 2. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of the  
13 requirement that an applicant submit a full set of fingerprints to the Department within the  
14 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-285(E)(2).

15 3. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes providing incomplete  
16 information in the license application within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(A)(1).

17 4. Respondent's conduct as described above constitutes the violation of any  
18 provision of A.R.S. Title 20 or any rule, subpoena or order of the director within the meaning of  
19 A.R.S. §20-295(A)(2).

20 5. Grounds exist for the Director to suspend, revoke, or refuse to renew  
21 Respondent's insurance license, impose a civil penalty and/or order restitution pursuant to  
22 A.R.S. §§20-295(A) and (F).

### 23 ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Respondent shall immediately submit her fingerprints and an Illegible Fingerprint  
Replacement Form to the Department.

2 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

3 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action  
4 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners  
5 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to  
6 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative  
7 action on any license application.


