CONSENT ORDER

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Mark Allen Miklich** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Mark Allen Miklich, ("Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident accident/health producer, Arizona license number 1083380, which expires July 31, 2018.
2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: c/o AFLAC, 209 E. Baseline Road, #E203, Tempe, AZ 85283 (business and mailing).
3. On or about July 31, 2014, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a resident accident/health producer, Arizona license number 1083380.
4. On February 9, 2015, the Department notified Respondent by mail at his address of record that his fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before March 11, 2015. Respondent did not reply to the Department's request.





1 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except as  
2 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to him to induce him to enter into this  
3 Consent Order and that he has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

4 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the  
5 Director is solely to settle this matter against him and does not preclude any other agency,  
6 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal  
7 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

8 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action  
9 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners  
10 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that he must report this administrative action to  
11 any and all states in which he holds an insurance license and must disclose this administrative  
12 action on any license application.


