The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Jeannie Belle Quiggle** has violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S."). Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jeannie Belle Quiggle, ("Respondent") is, and was at all material times licensed as a resident life and accident/health producer, Arizona license number 1103125, which expires August 31, 2018.
2. Respondent's addresses of record with the Department are: 14414 N. 36th Avenue, Phoenix, AZ 85053 (business and mailing).
3. On or about February 6, 2015, the Department issued to Respondent an insurance license as a resident life and accident/health producer, Arizona license number 1103125.
4. On June 12, 2015, the Department notified Respondent by mail at her address of record that her fingerprint card had been processed and returned by the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) as illegible. The Department requested a replacement set of fingerprints along with a completed "Illegible Fingerprint Replacement Form" on or before July 13, 2015. Respondent did not reply to the Department's request.

16 expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to her to induce her to enter into this
17 Consent Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

18 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
19 Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency,
20 officer, or subdivision of this state including the Department from instituting civil or criminal
21 proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future not related to this matter.

22 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
23 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners

1 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that she must report this administrative action to
2 any and all states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this
3 administrative action on any license application.


