CONSENT ORDER

Respondent.

The State of Arizona Department of Insurance ("Department") has received evidence that **Dominique N. Dietrich ("Respondent")** violated provisions of Title 20, Arizona Revised Statutes. Respondent wishes to resolve this matter without the commencement of formal proceedings, and admits the following Findings of Fact are true and consents to entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Dominique N. Dietrich ("Dietrich" or "Respondent") is licensed as an Arizona resident accident/health and life insurance producer, Arizona license number 1000515, which expires October 31, 2018. The Department first licensed Dietrich on September 12, 2011. Dietrich formerly held a license in the name Dominique Thomas.

2. Dietrich's address of record is: 8777 E. Via De Ventura #300, Scottsdale, AZ 85258 (business and mailing).

ANONYMOUS COMPLAINTS - 2015

3. On or about September 22, 2015, the Department received information alleging that Dietrich visited an elderly Arizona consumer's residence and informed the consumer that she was a government employee of both the State of Arizona and a Federal Medicare employee.

1 4. On September 29, 2015, a Department contacted the Arizona complainant
2 who informed the Department that Dietrich, on or about September 19, 2015, was at the
3 complainant's home to discuss their Medicare entitlements. When Dietrich was asked if
4 she was a federal employee, Dietrich replied that she was. Dietrich also informed the
5 consumer that she was "with the State."

6 5. Dietrich provided the consumer an expired copy of her Arizona producer
7 license and informed them that she was there to discuss their Medicare entitlements and
8 that she was a Medicare Specialist. The consumer indicated that Dietrich failed to inform
9 them that she was there to solicit Medicare Supplement insurance coverage.

11 **PIERCE COMPLAINT - 2012**

12 6. On or about June 27, 2012, the Department received a complaint from Paul
13 Pierce ("Pierce") alleging that Dietrich came to his residence requesting to speak with his
14 spouse regarding Social Security and Medicare entitlements. Pierce stated that when
15 Dietrich was asked if she worked for the government, Dietrich responded that she did and
16 was a federal employee there to speak with Mrs. Pierce regarding her benefit entitlements.
17 Dietrich provided Pierce with a business card indicating that she was a Medicare Specialist
18 but was unable to provide Pierce with identification to support that she was a federal
19 government employee. Pierce states that Dietrich failed to inform him that she was there
20 to solicit Medicare Supplement Insurance coverage information.
21

22 **BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS**

23 7. On May 13, 2014, The Department mailed a letter to Dietrich requesting
24 additional information regarding the Pierce complaint filed with the Department in 2012.
25 The Department's letter was returned as undeliverable by the postal service.

1 policyholder to lapse, forfeit, surrender, retain or convert any insurance policy, within the
2 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-443.

3 6. It is unlawful for a person to knowingly make any misrepresentation as
4 proscribed by A.R.S. §20-443 in the sale of insurance. A person who violates this section
5 is guilty of a class 5 felony. A.R.S. § 20-443.01.

6 7. Grounds exist for the Director to deny, suspend for not more than twelve
7 months, revoke, or refuse to renew an insurance producer's license pursuant to A.R.S. §
8 20-295(A).

9 8. Grounds exist for the Director, in addition to or instead of any suspension,
10 revocation or refusal to renew, impose a civil penalty of not more than two hundred fifty
11 dollars for each unintentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil penalty of two
12 thousand five hundred dollars, or impose a civil penalty of not more than two thousand
13 five hundred dollars for each intentional failure or violation, up to an aggregate civil
14 penalty of fifteen thousand dollars, within the meaning of A.R.S. § 20-295(F).

15 9. Grounds exist for the Director to order Respondent to cease and desist
16 making any misrepresentation in violation of A.R.S. §§ 20-443 and 20-443.01, within the
17 meaning of A.R.S. § 20-456.

22 **ORDER**

23 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

24 1. Respondent shall immediately pay a civil penalty of \$3250.00 for deposit into
25 the State General Fund.

1 2. Respondent shall immediately cease and desist making any misrepresentation in
 2 violation of A.R.S. §§ 20-443 and 20-443.01.

 9 **CONSENT TO ORDER**

15 3. Respondent is aware of her right to notice and hearing at which she may be
 16 represented by counsel, present evidence and examine witnesses. Respondent
 17 irrevocably waives her right to such notice and hearing and to any court appeals relating to
 18 this Consent Order.


19 4. Respondent states that no promise of any kind or nature whatsoever, except
 20 as expressly contained in this Consent Order, was made to her to induce her to enter into
 21 this Consent Order and that she has entered into this Consent Order voluntarily.

22 5. Respondent acknowledges that the acceptance of this Consent Order by the
 23 Director is solely to settle this matter against her and does not preclude any other agency,
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 25

1 including the Department, officer, or subdivision of this state or this agency from instituting
2 civil or criminal proceedings as may be appropriate now or in the future.

3 6. Respondent acknowledges that this Consent Order is an administrative action
4 that the Department will report to the National Association of Insurance Commissioners
5 (NAIC). Respondent further acknowledges that she must report this administrative action
6 to any and all states in which she holds an insurance license and must disclose this
7 administrative action on any license application.
