FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. CIFG Assurance North America, Inc. ("Petitioner") is a New York domiciled insurance company that received its certificate of authority to transact casualty insurance in Arizona effective April 13, 2004.
- Petitioner, the non-surviving entity, merged into Assured Guaranty Corp. (AGC), 2. NAIC No. 30180, the surviving entity, a Maryland domiciled insurer effective July 5, 2016. AGC is authorized to transact insurance in Arizona. Petitioner voluntarily surrendered its certificate of authority to the Department.
- 3. The Insurance Commissioner of New York approved the merger of Petitioner into AGC on June 30, 2016.
- 4. Petitioner has no outstanding obligations under any policy of insurance, whether written direct or through reinsurance ceded to it, to policyholders or claimants who are residents of this State.
