

**ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF INSURANCE  
ANNUAL REGULATORY AGENDA**

The Arizona Department of Insurance (the “Department”) has prepared and made this annual regulatory agenda available to the public in accordance with the requirements of A.R.S. § 41-1021.02.
