

**ORDER VACATING
SUSPENSION ORDER**

9 Based upon reliable evidence provided to the Director of Insurance by the Assistant
10 Director of the Financial Affairs Division of the Arizona Department of Insurance
11 ("Department"), the Director finds as follows:

FINDINGS OF FACT

13 1. Respondent, American Benefit Life Insurance Company is an Oklahoma
14 domiciled life and disability insurer initially granted authority to transact life and disability
15 insurance business on April 12, 1963.

16 2. On June 6, 1997, the District Court for Oklahoma County State of Oklahoma
17 issued a Journal Entry, Case No. CJ-97-2518-62, appointing receiver and directing submission
18 of a plan of rehabilitation.

19 3. On September 26, 1997, the Director issued an order suspending the certificate
20 of authority of Respondent based upon Respondent's failure to meet the requirements for the
21 authority originally granted to it within the meaning of Arizona Revised Statutes ("A.R.S.") §20-
22 219(2).
